



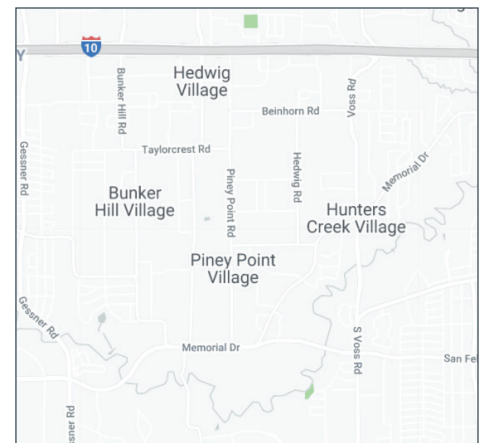

Things to Love About The Memorial Villages

- “The Memorial Villages,” include the cities of Bunker Hill Village, Hedwig Village, Piney Point Village, and Hunters Creek Village. The four neighborhoods south of Interstate 10: Hedwig, Bunker Hill, Piney Point, and Hunters Creek are sometimes referred to as the Memorial Villages proper while the two township north of Interstate 10 are sometimes referred to as the Memorial Villages North. These six independent cities, however, all operate autonomously of Houston with each having their own mayor and village government and fire and police coverage.
- When a Houstonian says, “Memorial,” he or she is referring to the vast area that stretches west from Loop-610, south of Interstate 10 and north of Buffalo Bayou, along Memorial Drive all the way to Beltway 8.
- Characterized by a country-in-the-city atmosphere undisturbed by commercial development, Memorial neighborhoods offer large wooded lots, winding streets, narrow lanes, some of the most exclusive – and expensive – residences in Houston, and award-winning Spring Branch Independent School District schools.
- Upscale commercial and retail establishments cluster along Beltway 8 and provide Memorial residents with access to some of the nest shopping, dining, hospital and office spaces in Houston, including CityCentre and Memorial City Mall.
- The Memorial Villages were ranked as the fifth safest city in Texas based on an analysis of violent and property crimes by Security Baron.



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
